DOAC Urine Dipstick Program

Program suitable for detection of Direct Oral Anticoagulants in urine samples using (DOASENSE) urine dipstick.

Frequency (No of surveys/year): 2

Cases/samples per survey: 2

Schedule: May, November

Sample type:

Lyophilised urine. Reconstitution consumables provided

Measurands:

Creatinine, Thrombin Inhibitor, Xa Inhibitor

Assessment:

Qualitative interpretation of measurands

Storage and handling:

Refrigerate samples (2-8°C) upon receipt

Transport:

Exempt human, shipped and stable at ambient temperatures

Shipment frequency:

Packaged kit box containing all samples and consumables for full schedule of testing. Dispatched once a year, before first survey open.

DOAC Urine Dipstick

- Rapid point-of-care qualitative strip test for detecting Direct Oral Anticoagulants (DOAC Dipstick) in urine.
- Excludes presence of clinically relevant DOAC (both factor Xa inhibitors and thrombin inhibitors) concentrations.
- Useful when medication history is unavailable and where laboratory testing for DOACs is not available.
- The DOAC Dipstick test can provide rapid decision support for patients with severe bleeding or patients with indication for an intervention, e.g., in trauma surgery or neurology.
